## **Trailer Pre-Trip Inspection Checklist**

Tires  ☐ Check tire pressure (cold) and inflate to maximum PSI.
☐ Inspect all tires for cracks, bulges, worn tread, or dry rot.
☐ Make sure you have a good spare tire, inflated properly.
☐ Inspect lug nuts and make sure they are tight.
Hitch and Coupler
☐ Inspect hitch ball and coupler for tight, secure fit.
$\square$ Ensure latch is locked down and secured with a safety pin or lock.
$\hfill\square$ Make sure safety chains are crossed underneath and attached securely.
$\square$ Check that breakaway cable is properly connected.
Lights and Electrical  ☐ Test brake lights, turn signals, and running lights.
$\square$ Inspect 7-pin connector or wiring harness for damage.
$\square$ Test electric trailer brakes if equipped.
<b>Load and Weight</b> ☐ Confirm cargo is properly loaded and evenly distributed.
$\square$ Secure all cargo tightly using straps, chains, or nets.
$\square$ Check tongue weight is about 10 to 15 percent of trailer weight.
$\hfill\Box$ Ensure total trailer weight is within towing vehicle capacity.
Brakes and Suspension  ☐ Check for proper brake function.
$\Box$ Listen for unusual noises while moving slowly.
☐ Check leaf springs, u-bolts, and shackles for damage.

General Safety  ☐ Bring tire repair kit and portable air compressor.
$\hfill\Box$ Carry torque wrench, breaker bar, socket set, and bottle jack.
$\square$ Carry first aid kit and basic roadside emergency kit.
$\square$ Bring extra wheel chocks.
$\square$ Check insurance and registration documents.
Optional Extra Checks  ☐ Test breakaway brake system if equipped.
☐ Lubricate hitch ball with grease.
$\square$ Check spare hub assembly if possible.
